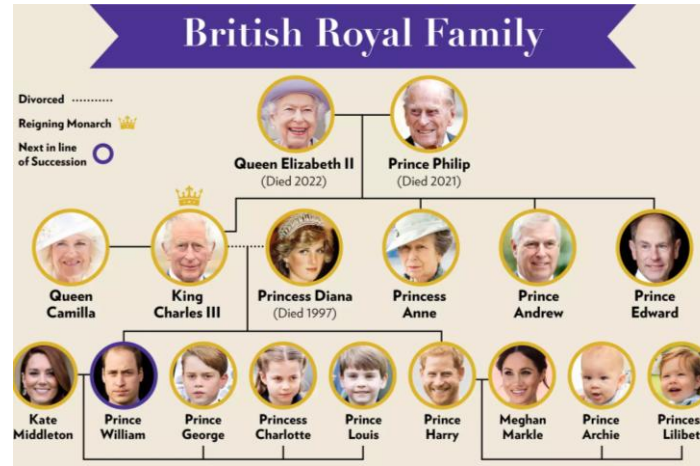

Modern Monarchs

TERMS Key Vocabulary

King	Male ruler of a country who usually inherits his position
Queen	Female ruler of a country who usually inherits her position, or wife of a King
Monarch	The King or Queen
Coronation	Ceremony at which a King or Queen is crowned
Reign	Period of time that a monarch rules
Government	Group of people who rule and lead a country
Monarchy	A system of which one person reigns
Heir	Next in line to the throne
Prince	Son of a monarch
Princess	Daughter of a monarch

- He was crowned King on the 8th of September 2022.
- Charles III can speak Welsh.
- Charles is a qualified pilot and diver.
- King Charles III is a talented artist.
- King Charles has founded almost 20 charities.
- His mother was Queen Elizabeth II and he became monarch when she died.

CHRONOLOGY - Main Events

- 1952 - Queen Elizabeth became Queen
- 1948 - Charles was born and he was 3 years old when the Queen was coronated
- 1958 - Charles became Prince of Wales
- 1982 & 1984 - William and Harry were born
- 2022 - Queen died in September
- 2023 - Coronation of King Charles



- Queen Elizabeth was the longest reigning British Monarch in history.
- Elizabeth was born in 1926.
- She became Queen in 1952.
- Her coronation took place in 1953.
- She was married to Philip Mountbatten (Prince Philip).
- She had four children who are all still alive: King Charles, Princess Anne, Prince Andrew, Prince Edward.
