Painting

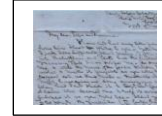
Paint a colourful seaside picture with:

Create a seaside treasure hunt for someone when they go to the seaside. Think about things such as:

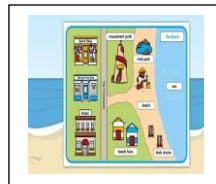
- Shells
