

## Year 6 Greeks Home Learning Challenges



**HISTORY**  
Research one key event from Ancient Greek history (e.g. the Battle of Marathon, the Olympics, or the Trojan War). Create a short timeline or fact page showing what happened and why it was important.

OR

Find out about a famous Ancient Greek person (e.g. Alexander the Great, Socrates, Plato, or Hippocrates) and write a short biography explaining their achievements.



### DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

Build a model of an Ancient Greek temple using cardboard, LEGO, or recycled materials. Try to include columns and detailed features.

OR

Design a Greek-style shield inspired by warriors from Sparta or myths from Ancient Greece.

### ENGLISH

Write a myth set in Ancient Greece. You could include gods, monsters, heroes, and a moral lesson.

OR

Imagine you are a child living in Ancient Greece. Write a diary entry describing your daily life in Athens or Sparta.

### GEOGRAPHY

Draw a map of Ancient Greece and label important city-states such as Athens and Sparta. Add seas, islands, and neighbouring regions.

**MATHS**  
Investigate how the Ancient Greeks used mathematics. Find out about Pythagoras or geometry and present your findings using diagrams or examples.

OR

Create a data chart showing results from the Ancient Olympic Games (events, winners, or types of competitions) and display it as a bar chart or table.



### ART

Create a Greek theatre mask showing either comedy or tragedy. Think about shape, colour, and expression.



**MUSIC**  
Research music and instruments from Ancient Greece. Create a fact sheet or try to recreate rhythms using instruments or body percussion.

**COMPUTING**  
Create a PowerPoint, Google Slides, or poster presentation about an aspect of Ancient Greece (gods, city-states, Olympics, or daily life). Include images, captions, and key facts.

OR

Design a simple quiz about Ancient Greece for your classmates to test their knowledge.
